Country/region/implementer	Title of the initiative	Key objective / focus
Argentina	Humanitarian Visa Program	In May 2022, the Argentinian government created a new humanitarian visa to enable people displaced by climate disasters from Mexico, Central America and the Caribbean to freely reside in the country for three years.
Haiti	10-year strategic plan for disaster management	The plan calls for a resilient perspective in Haiti while promoting sustainable and inclusive development, advancing target E of the Sendai Framework for Disaster Risk Reduction 2015-2030, which aims to increase the number of countries with national and local disaster risk reduction strategies by 2020.
Nigeria	Establishment of a National Council of Environment and climate change	The Council provides a sustainable policy framework and an enabling environment for climate change action in Nigeria, in order to regularly update information regarding national greenhouse gas emission, mitigation options, vulnerability assessment and adaptation measures to the impacts of climate change.
Zimbabwe	National Climate Policy	The National Climate Policy was based on robust science, stakeholder consultations, review of the current plans, strategies and policies, legal and regulatory analysis. The Policy addresses four thematic areas: (1) Weather, Climate Modelling and Change, (2) Vulnerability and Adaptation, (3) Mitigation and Low Carbon Development and (4) Enablers/Cross Cutting Issue

Zimbabwe	Management of Tongogara Refugee Camp	In collaboration with UNHCR, IOM, and WFP, the government has donated 150 hectares of land for settlement, which has allowed refugees to engage in resilience and livelihood programs, allowing them to venture into various businesses.
UN Women	Ensuring safe and regular migration for women and girls in the context of climate change	Produced as part of the Germany-funded "To Make Immigration Safe for Women" project, this policy brief explores the linkages among gender, migration and climate change, and provides recommendations to policymakers and practitioners to ensure safe and regular migration for women and girls in the context of climate change.
African Union	Africa Climate Mobility Initiative (ACMI)	The Africa Climate Mobility Initiative is a people-centred and evidence-based Initiative, aiming to generate political momentum around a common policy agenda and mobilise resources for the implementation of comprehensive and locally anchored solutions to address climate mobility. The Africa Climate Mobility Initiative's cornerstones are knowledge-building, connecting and empowering change agents and accelerating policy and project implementation underpinned by strategic partnerships. Botswana accepted the role of championing Program for knowledge and data, recognizing the importance of addressing data gaps and blind spots in projections.
European Union	CLICIM project – Climate Change Induced Migration	The Joint research Centre of the European Commission conducted a study connecting migration drivers and climate change in various regions of Africa. The study highlighted the difficulty of connecting the dots at a macro level and identified specific situations where interventions are needed or possible.
European Union	EU Talent Pool Initiative	This initiative aims to create the first EU-wide matching tool to facilitate international recruitment, to make the EU more attractive to skilled workers from non-EU countries and help employers find the talent they need.
City of Paris	Climate Plan	The Paris Climate Plan sets new, ambitious targets for reducing greenhouse gas emissions (GHG), which are necessary to implement the Paris Agreement and details more than 500 measures in several areas of action (building, transport, energy, food, waste, living environment, mobilization, finance...).
City of Paris	Robustness and vulnerability studies	As a result of climate change, heat waves are on the increase in Paris. The consequences for the health and quality of life of Parisians are considerable. To prepare for this, the City of Paris is implementing a cooling strategy called "Paris s'adapte", with a range of measures.
City of Paris	Fabrique de la Solidarité Climate Academy	The Fabrique de la Solidarité is a mechanism and a place for citizen mobilization for Parisians who want to take action in the field of solidarity. The Académie du Climat is a collective space designed for and by young people aged 9 to 25. The aim is to give them the means to learn about the challenges of climate change, so that they can take effective action to build the world of tomorrow. Both institutions are also starting to work together on risk management, learning from each other.

Mayors Migration Council	Support African cities delivering solutions for migrants and displaced people affected by climate crisis	The organization is currently funding 11 African cities to implement climate migration projects.
Secours Catholique	Research on the intersections between climate change and environmental mobility	A study conducted in Honduras, Bangladesh and Senegal, which finding will be published in September.
