Components of the PfP

▶ Online repository:

- ▶ 1,000 M&D practices and policy tools → GFMD discussions
- ▶ Space to make calls for action or partnership

▶ Session at GFMD Summit Meetings:

- ▶ Face-to-face interactions → sharing experiences between governments and key partners

GFMD Ten-Year Review

- ▶ Added value of the GFMD → threefold:
 - ▶ Offering networking opportunities
 - ▶ Facilitating partnerships
 - ▶ Acquiring knowledge

► Initial Concept

Governments submit their request for services (posted on a special website)

Service providers (e.g. governments, IOs, NGOs or private sector entities) respond to requests and exchange views (chatbox)

Requesting governments review responses and decide on the providers they wish to meet for further exchange

Marketplace meetings are held with one or multiple providers (in 1-hour time slots, parallel to Roundtable sessions and Future of the Forum session)

GFMD 2007 Marketplace

Highlights

1. 32 Marketplace consultations took place during the Meeting
2. 20 Project proposals were submitted primarily by developing countries.
3. 12 of these proposals were followed up by a provider
4. Actual follow-up varied from discussions on project proposals to implementation

Aspects for consideration

1. Increase awareness by encouraging whole-of-government approach → PfP
2. Participation in the Marketplace during Roundtable and Future of the Forum sessions
3. Identify funding mechanisms (e.g., UN capacity building mechanism, government donors, foundations)
4. Strong coordination and coherent follow up (e.g. the Support Unit working with vital stakeholders (i.e., concerned governments, UN Network on migration, civil society, business, etc.)

The Marketplace Actors

- “Owners” – proponent member states with targeted policy / programme needs (also on behalf of civil society or private sector)
- “Providers” – governments, international organizations, foundations, civil society or private sector entities that have the capacity to offer assistance (financial, technical, operational, etc.)
- “Visitors” – interested stakeholders who want to observe and learn from the interaction before making a decision on how to get involved
- GFMD Support Unit – facilitator, connector, communicator
- UN Network on Migration – provides coordinated support from the UN on a need basis, i.e., as may be requested by the “Owners”

► Adapted Concept for 2019

- MS identify areas for capacity-building, bilateral or multilateral joint initiatives, after internal consultations with concerned M&D actors at the national level (i.e, whole-of-government approach)
- Linkages to GCM objectives and 2030 Agenda, if applicable, are specified.

Submit a corresponding request, GFMD (SU) acting as an interface

Requests and proposals are gathered for "matchmaking"

- SU reviews the requests, consults with donor governments, foundations and/or the UN Migration Network Secretariat
- SU establishes contacts between the "owner" and the "provider(s)" and opens a chatbox
- The entire process, beginning with the drafting of a project proposal, should remain as state-led.

- A "Marketplace"-meeting is being organized jointly by the GFMD Chair and UN Network, wherein sessions are broadly structured acc. to GCM-Objectives.
- Therein, interested governments, identified agencies and other stakeholders discuss implementation of the capacity-building proposals made.

- ▶ **Communication** - promotion, peer review and feedback
